

How to Disinfect Your Computer

Effective Computer Cleaning Procedures to stop the spread of COVID-19



POWER DOWN & UNPLUG PC

Shut down your PC in the operating system, then unplug it. If you are using an industrial or medical PC designed to be cleaned while powered on, use the lock-screen key.





WEAR DISPOSABLE GLOVES

Wearing gloves is the best way to protect yourself from exposure to the Coronavirus, especially if you are cleaning healthcare or public computers.





SPRAY DISINFECTANT ON CLOTH

Use a microfiber cloth. If you don't have microfiber, use 100% cotton or another soft material. Only use approved cleaning chemicals, as some chemicals will degrade the surface.





WIPE TOUCHSCREEN & BEZEL

With your microfiber cloth, wipe down the entire surface of the computer, leaving the surface visibly wet. Thoroughly clean crevices, such as the perimeter of the touchscreen.





DISPOSE OF GLOVES & CLOTH

If you used non-disposable gloves or cloth, wash them in hot soapy water after cleaning your computer. Also wash your hands when you are done cleaning.





DO NOT -



DO

Mix cleaning chemicals

Use high concentration of alcohol (>70%)

Use ammonia-based products

Directly spray the computer

Clean your computer in a well ventilated area away from flames

Read the product manual to verify cleaning agents

Clean personal devices daily and shared devices between each user
